AT LAST! Intermediate Program 2009

- **Registration:** By mail only.
- **Eligibility:** Students going into Grades 3-8 in September 2009.
- **Location:** Guggenheim Elementary School /other district facilities.
- **Time:** 9:30am-12:30pm
- **Dates:** Full Session: July 6-August 14; Mini-session I: July 6-July 24,
Mini-session II: July 27-August 14.
- **Transportation:** Available for all students in the Port Washington School District. May be delayed or unavailable to late registrants. Schedules will be distributed at Parent Orientation on Tuesday, June 16.
- **Early Drop-Off:** Children may be dropped off between 8:30 and 9:30 AM and will be supervised rain or shine in the cafetorium.
- **T-Shirts:** Three program T-shirts will be distributed at Parent Orientation. They are to be worn daily. Shirts available for sale at Orientation.
- **Activities:** Recreational and enrichment activities supervised by experienced staff in great facilities--many air conditioned classrooms.
- **Transfers:** Transfers are not encouraged. Changes must be requested in writing and can only be made the first two days of each session. There will be a \$10 charge for each class change. Of course, space must be available and all fees will apply. Material fees are not refundable.
- **Financial Assistance:** A limited number of scholarships are distributed based on eligibility for free or reduced lunch. See registration form.

The AT LAST! Program does not provide support services. Students who enroll should be able to maintain themselves adequately in a regular classroom setting appropriate for their age and grade in order to continue participation. The program reserves the right to withdraw any child. If you are uncertain about your child's ability to participate, please send a note with your registration form and we will contact you.

Registration Procedure

- * Consult the schedule of courses in this brochure.
- * From the Intermediate Program choices choose a first and second choice for each of the periods 1, 2, & 3 for the ODD and EVEN days.
- * Select 1 alternate course on the ODD and EVEN days.
- * Complete a separate registration form for each child.
- * Early-bird payment due by April 30, 2009. Full payment is due with registration no later than May 30, 2009. Check made out to Board of Education, Port Washington or you may pay by credit card. DO NOT include material fees. You will receive class confirmation and be billed for the material fees.
- * If you wish to take Summer Discoveries afternoon activities fill out lower box on registration form.
- * Refunds available less a \$100 processing fee until May 30, 2009. No refunds thereafter.
- * Parent Orientation on June 16, 2009 at Guggenheim School.

Summer Discoveries

Full Session: July 6 – August 14

Available to 3-8 grade students enrolled in the AT LAST! Program. Registrations by **MAIL ONLY**, and processed in order of receipt. Full payment due with registration form by May 30. Checks are payable to **“Board of Education, Port Washington.”** Refunds are available less a \$50 processing fee on May 30. No refunds thereafter. The program will meet daily, from 12:30-3:30 PM. Children will have lunch (brought from home) between 12:30 and 1:00 P.M. Afternoon bus stops may not be the same as the morning. **NEW:** Each session includes 45 minutes of outdoor recreation when meeting on site.
